Hidden Treasure: Property In California

Dormant bank accounts can be considered as one of the most common types of unclaimed money. The office of unclaimed property in California has with them a record containing the names of people and their corresponding amounts whose accounts have not been touched for more than a decade. This money is judged as unclaimed property in California by the state if nobody comes to claim it.

Well the question that might arise is that if you are not aware of its existence the how can you possibly claim it? Then the first thing to do is to look for your name in the records to see if any unclaimed property in California is present. This can be done in several ways. A visit to the Office of the Comptroller is the cheapest and most effective way. A website is also available so that people can search the record to see if there is any unclaimed property in California in their name. This method is very secure so details of any proceeds that may belong to you can't be viewed by any random person.

Once you have found some unclaimed property in your name the next thing to do is to get your hands on the money. To do this you may have to provide a range of specific details which also depends on what unclaimed property you have. The first and the most obvious would be the proof of identity while the other could be a proof of your previous address which can be obtained through several methods.

If your own name is not present on the site but you do find a relative's this too could potentially be good news. You could inform them that there is unclaimed property in California in their name and then lead them to the website. If they can't get access to the Internet the call them over and assist them to find all the necessary data. And if your relatives are feeling generous they might just give you a portion of their bounty

You might also find deceased family member's names on the list of unclaimed property in California. If that person was some one close to you, you could present a death certificate with any documentation establishing the fact that you are their heir to claim the money. You might also seek the help of a lawyer while dealing with the unclaimed property in California office if the amount happens to be quite large. You would want to handle everything properly so that there would be no issues regarding you claiming what belong to your family.
